- Even More Powerful Scripts
- Live Install
 - You're going to love it
 - It's not dangerous
 - No more Systems on your disk
- Network installations? You bet!





Your Installation Strategy

- If you could possibly drag it over, don't use the Installer
- One Function One Icon
 - AppleShare should be one icon
 - ADSP should not exist

Why I Might Need the Installer



- 800K is really so small
- The Installer is your access to the system file
 - But why are you changing the system?
- You are installing multiple applications

Welcome to the Apple Installer




Your Macintosh needs certain software to start up.

The Installer places this software on your disk in the System Folder.




"Easy Install" chooses the software Apple recommends and creates a disk which can be used to start up your Macintosh.

("Customize" if you are sure you want to override those recommendations.)




