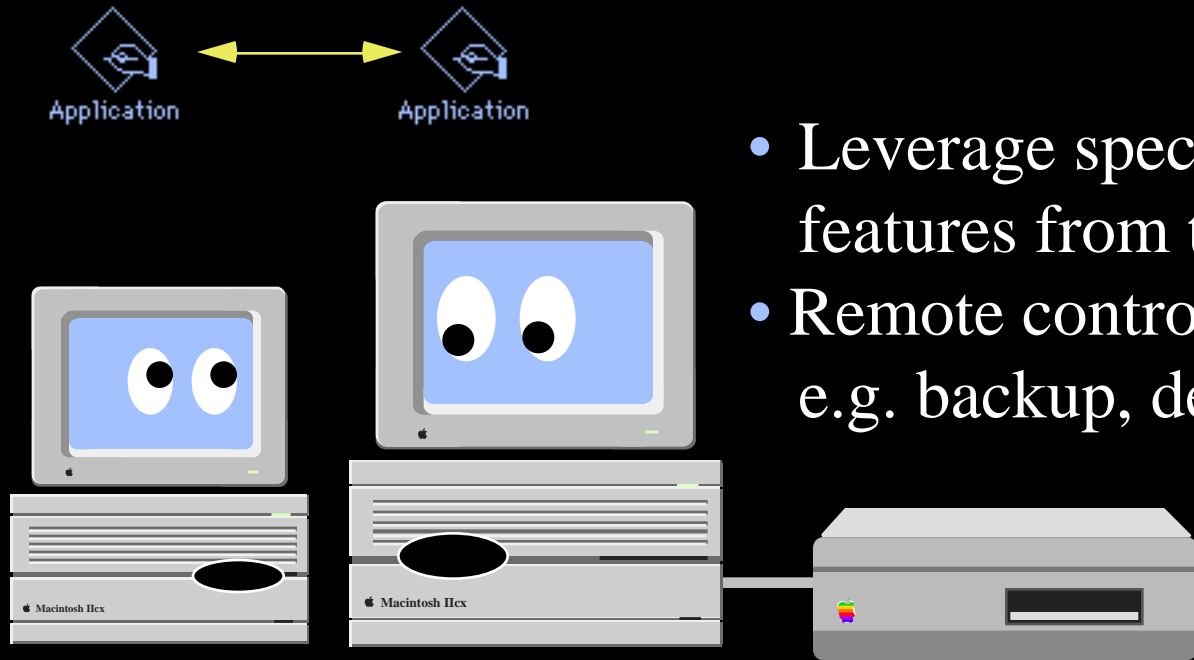
# Goals for IAC

---

## Beyond the clipboard

- Automated copy/paste
- Application cooperation
  - Sharing capabilities
  - Leverage the best parts
- A foundation for user scripting

# IAC: Some Scenarios



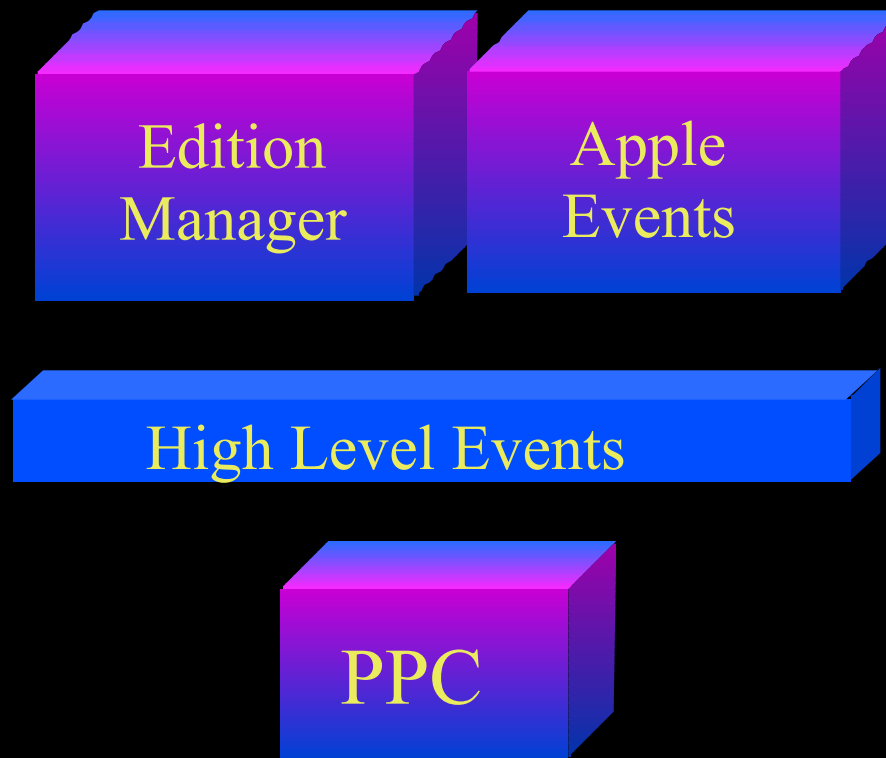
- Leverage specialized features from the pros
- Remote control e.g. backup, debug

- The Edition Manager
  - A (new) metaphor for sharing data
- High level event manager and PPC toolbox
  - Telephone and simple protocols
- AppleEvents
  - Something to talk about

---

Use this first!

- Publish and Subscribe metaphor
  - Documents always up-to-date
- Intermediate “Edition” files
  - Operates across network
- Extensive toolbox support
  - 3 new dialogs

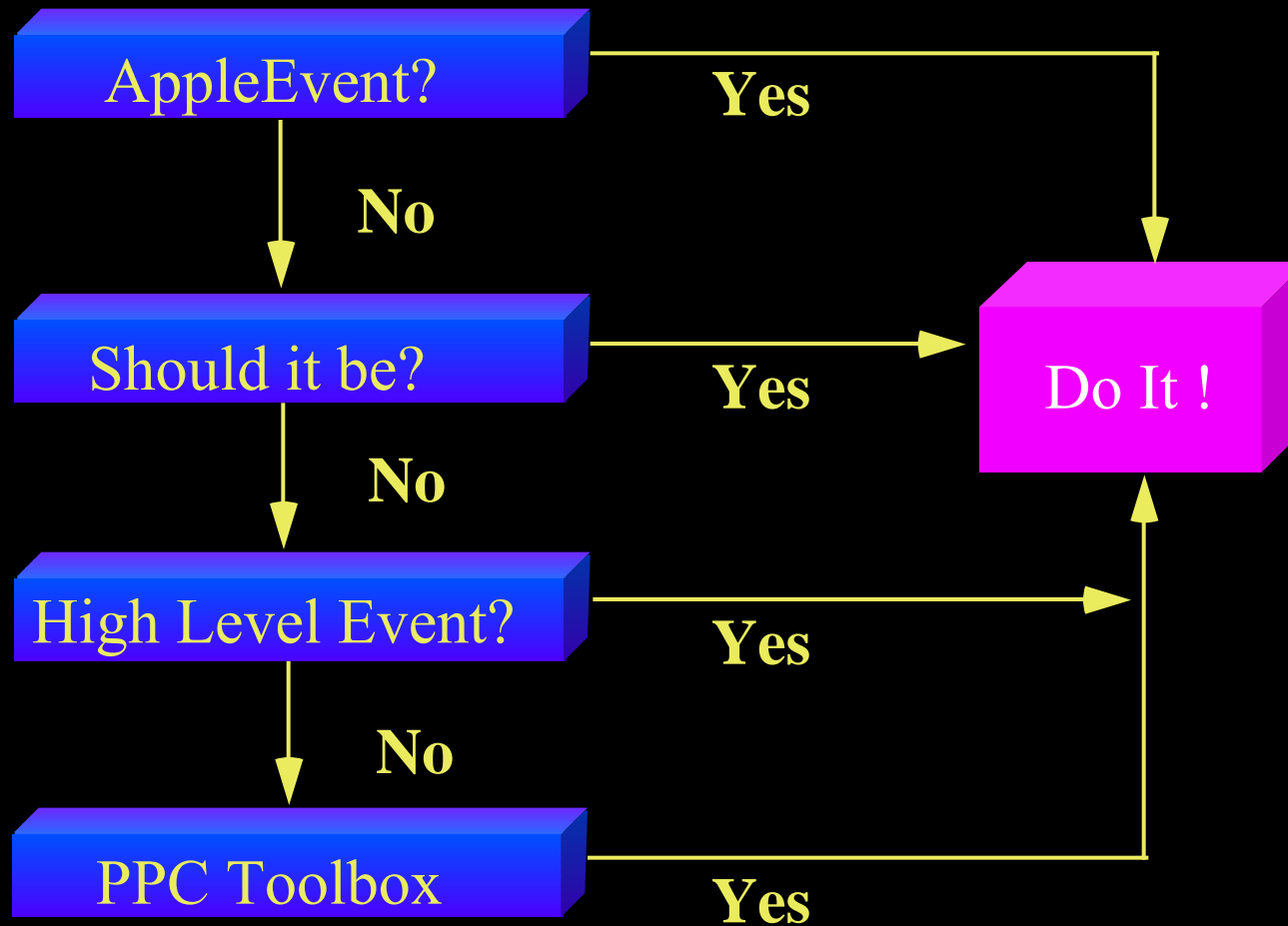
# AppleEvents

Accept required events now!

- Four easy events get you started
- Standard events take you further
  - Core, text, graphics, finder, ...
  - We need your involvement
- Toolbox support
